#### **ORDINANCE NO.769**

#### TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Warrensburg, in the County of Macon and State of Illinois, did on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2021, pass the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for said Village for the fiscal year beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May, 2021, the amount of which is ascertained to be the aggregate sum of Two Million, Seventy-One Thousand, Five Hundred Eighteen Dollars and No Cents (\$2,071,518.00), which said Appropriation Ordinance was duly published on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2021.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WARRENSBURG, ILLINOIS:

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the Village of Warrensburg Illinois, and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with, the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation Act".
